Resolution Concerning the Replacement Cost for Twelve Fire Dampers To come from the Highlands Reserve Account

Whereas fire dampers are products used in heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) ducts to prevent the spread of fire inside the ductwork,

Whereas twelve of our thirty-six fire dampers are failing to open for normal operation and are needing to be replaced, causing them to fail to meet fire codes; and

Whereas the replacement cost for these twelve fire dampers is \$27,980.00, which exceeds the allocated \$23,500.00 budgeted in the Highlands Congregation's Building and Grounds Account; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that

The Highlands Congregation approve that the total Building and Grounds Expenses that exceed \$23,500.00 come from the Highlands Reserve Account.

Highlands Congregational Business Meeting December 6, 2020

A congregational business meeting was held following worship on December 6, 2020 and began at 11:30 a.m. Wendy Gunn, Pastor of Record, opened the meeting and announced the singing of hymn #636, Ï Have Called You by Your Name" followed by a prayer by Dawn Pagat. Since the business meeting was held on zoom, Allen Keehler gave instructions for voting.

The minutes of the November 22, 2020 meeting were presented and Allen Keehler moved the minutes be approved as written and seconded by Dawn Pagat. Motion passed.

Wendy Gunn said the Leadership Board presented the name of Lehi German as Congregational Life Pastor. She explained that there had been two other candidates, Bryan Parrott and Barbara Freund. They both withdrew their names this last week. Wendy Gunn proceeded to open it up for additional nominations from the floor. There were no nominations. Wendy Gunn presented again the name of Lehi German as Congregational Life Pastor from the nomination of the Leadership Board and asked for a second. Preston Pagat seconded. Lehi made a few comments. A vote was called to elect Lehi German as Congregational Life Pastor. The vote was approved unanimously.

Then the 2021 Leadership Roster was presented. Kathy Ruoff moved to sustain all those listed in leadership to be approved by one vote and Dawn Pagat seconded. All the Leadership were approved as listed.

Since there was no new business, the meeting adjourned at 12:05 p.m.




